Classes: **Puppy :** For dogs from 9 to 18 months on the date of the test

Novice Dog/Novice Handler (unclassified): Neither dog nor handler to have won **any** award, including certificate of merit at a Field Trial, or **ANY** Working Test, **including ND/NH**

Novice: for dogs that have not gained an award or COM at a field trial, been placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd in an Open working test or 1st in a Novice working test.

Open: Open to all dogs (preference will be given to qualified dogs)

Entries: All classes £8.00 per dog (members), £10.00 per dog (Non-members) Dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club.
