Each Area or Club will be represented by a **single team** consisting of:
One dog of Open standard, two Novice standard, one Novice Dog/Novice Handler or Puppy, the definitions for which are:

- Puppy:** From six months to eighteen months old on day of the test
ND/NH: Neither dog nor handler to have won an award at a field trial or working test with the exception of Puppy/Special Puppy or an award, other than 1st in ND/NH
- Novice:** For dogs that have not gained an award or COM at a field trial, been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open working test or 1st in a Novice or Intermediate working test. **For the Novice qualification for this Test, wins after 17th April 2022 will not be counted**
- Open:** For dogs of Open standard.
- NB:** **Some tests will be accompanied by gunfire and puppies/ND/NH's will be expected to enter water. THE LOWEST SCORE IN EACH TEAM, AT EACH TEST WILL BE DISCARDED WHEN COUNTING THE TEAM SCORES.**

As this is a team event, none of the awards will count towards entry criteria for any other working test, classified or unclassified, or for the Culmquill GWT Trophy points. However, dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club and their Owners members of the FCRS, NEFRA, Flatcoated Retriever Club of Scotland or the Southern Flatcoated Retriever Club.
