1. For Flatcoated Retrievers (Dogs & Bitches) aged between 12 and 18 months.

5. All classes must have a minimum of three dogs entered and present to qualify for collation.
6. Any dog entered and present in any other class will be classed as present, whether withdrawn or not, for the sake of collating points.
