• The dog has been tested in line.

- The dog has shown that it is not gun shy
- The dog hunted for, and found, dead or wounded game, faced cover, and retrieved tenderly.
- The dog entered water freely, swam and retrieved. If a natural retrieve is not possible a dummy may be used.
- The dog has not barked or whined in line.
- The dog has been under reasonable control, absolute steadiness is not essential.

#### DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE

Directions from Exeter or Okehamptn: Please approach via the A377.

From Crediton: Take the road to Sandford. When you reach Sandford, follow the road towards Kennerleigh, take the first right (in the village) turn towards East Village (narrow and tight, you will pass the village school on your left). Continue, at junction, turn left. Follow the road for approx % mile, round to the right, over a bridge, up a steep hill, as you go down the hill, a sharp right hand bend. Signs for parking will be out from here.

From the M5 junction 27 towards Tiverton A361, then take the A396 (towards Bickleigh/Exeter) at Bickleigh turn right towards Crediton A3072. Just as you enter turn right signposted to Sandford, at the crossroads, turn right towards Sandford. When you reach Sandford, follow the road towards Kennerleigh take the first right turn towards East Village (narrow and tight, you will pass the village school on your left). Continue, at junction, turn left. Follow the road for approx 3/4 mile, follow the road round to the right, over a bridge, up a steep hill, as you go down the hill, a sharp right hand bend. Signs for parking will be out from here.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2 The committee have the power, if they think fit, to refuse any entry for the trial without assigning any reason for their action. The Kennel Club must be notified in writing of all such refusals with the Club's reasons.
- 3 A competitor withdrawing from the trial is requested to give the F.T. secretary at least 2 day's notice. A veterinary certificate or written confirmation that the bitch came into season will be required. The substitution of entries will be allowed up to 48 hours of the stake being run, subject to a veterinary certificate being produced.
- 4 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 5 If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
- 6 Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 7 No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 8 Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

### 9 DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

#### 10 Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars or prong collars is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
